



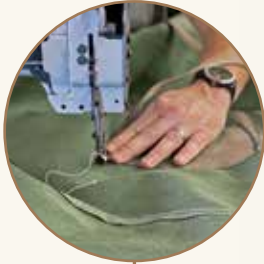
# YOUR CANVAS TENT CARE GUIDE

## CRAFTMANSHIP



Canvas tent craftsmanship begins with the best fabric and proper stitching of the canvas.

When customers are handing tents down to the next generation, you know you're doing something right.

## CLEAN



- Dirt can be removed by "smacking" the canvas with your hand or a broom.
- Ground in dirt or oil can be removed with a mild soapy solution, like diluted Lysol, and a soft brush.

## STORE

- Make sure your tent is completely dry, then store your tent in a dry location. Canvas functions best when allowed to breathe.
- Do not store your tent in an airtight container or mildew will collect.

## REPAIR

- If a tear occurs in the body of your tent, it can be fixed quickly with duct tape, then patched and sewn for a reliable, long-term solution.
- Because our canvas is naturally water resistant, we do not recommend water-proofing it unless it presents issues.

Sturdy reinforced ridges mean your tent won't tear on a honed log frame.

Double-fill grade A canvas is naturally water resistant, sturdy and breathable.

Interior steel frame maximizes useable space and stability.

Double-sewn seams using high-tensile poly fiber ensures our stitches stay put.

Rope is durable with moderate stretch and easy knottability.
